Re: Petition for Approval of a Class Action Lawsuit

Bank Leumi Le-Israel Ltd. (“the Bank”) is pleased to report the following:

On 30 April 2015, the Bank received a petition for approval of class action which had been filed against the Bank in the Tel Aviv-Jaffa District Court on 29 April 2015.

The lawsuit involves an allegation made by the petitioner that the funds deposited by Holocaust survivors before the Second World War in the Anglo-Palestine Bank and which were not withdrawn by customers during the war, are returned to the survivors or to their heirs without having been revalued to their alleged real values.

The petitioner claims personal damages in the amount of NIS 251,266 and the amount of the class action is estimated at NIS 150 million.
