Re: **Agreement for the Sale of 10% of the Shares of SHVA (Automatic Banking Services Ltd.)**

Bank Leumi le-Israel B.M. (hereafter: “the **Bank**”) is pleased to report as follows:

1. In accordance with what is stated in the Immediate Report dated 21 November 2018 (Reference No. 2018-01-111591), the Bank – on 20 November 2018 – contracted with a corporation within the global Visa group (hereafter: “**Visa**”), for the sale to Visa of 10% of the shares of 10% of the shares of SHVA (Automatic Banking Services Ltd.).
2. On 3 December 2018, the Deputy Governor of the Bank of Israel and the acting Governor of the Bank of Israel granted Visa a permit to hold up to 10% of the means of control in SHVA.
3. The completion of the transaction s subject to the satisfaction of an additional condition precedent.
